2. Read Requirements Carefully

Most scholarships require:

- 6-12 credit hours completed (graduate awards excluded)
- 2.0–3.0 Overall GPA (varies with award)
- Currently enrolled in at least 6 credit hours
- Some require an essay of 400-500 words
- Financial need considered but not required
- College and community service considered
- 2plus2 and Distinguished Graduate require interviews
- Current, sealed official transcript www.valenciacc.edu/records
- References from Valencia faculty, staff and others
- Complete application packet arrives in the Alumni Relations office by deadline

3. Create A High-Quality Packet

- Explain why **you** should be selected
- Tell your real dreams and goals
- Keep essay within the word limit
- Use references that really know you and your dreams
- Send **current, sealed**, official transcript
- Make sure your packet arrives on time

4. Interviewing for 2plus2 & Distinguished Graduate Awards

- Be on time
- Wear business dress-need not be expensive
- Be courteous
- Be yourself but not too casual or comical
- Listen carefully to the questions
- Take a minute to think before answering
- Make eye contact with the interviewers
- Explain, when asked, your specific strengths
- Thank your interviewers
