DESTINY HF: Once a day dosing of Diovan for Heart Failure patients

ATHENA: Anti-Arrhythmic For Atrial Fibrillation (Dronadron)

RELY: Stroke prevention in Atrial Fibrillation (Dabigitran)

RHEOS: Implantable device study for Hypertension

SITAXSENTIAN: Randomized, double-blind, placebo controlled exploratory efficacy study of Sitaxentan Sodium to improve impaired exercise tolerance in subjects with Diastolic Heart Failure.

PRECISION: Randomized, double-blind, parallel group study of cardiovascular safety in Osteoarthritis or Rheumatoid Arthritis patients with or at high risk for Cardiovascular Disease comparing Celecoxib with Naproxen or Ibuprofen.

RELIANT: Randomized, double-blind, placebo controlled, parallel group trial to assess the efficacy and safety of Omacor for the prevention of recurrent, symptomatic Atrial Fibrillation.

CRESCENDO: Randomized, multi-national, multi-center, double-blind, placebo controlled, two arm-parallel group trial of Rimonabant 20-mg QD for reducing the risk of major cardiovascular events in abdominally obese patients with clustering risk factors.

TRA 2P: Study to evaluate the safety and efficacy of SCH 530348 in addition to standard of care in subjects with a history of Atherosclerotic Disease: Thrombin Receptor Antagonist in secondary prevention of Atherothrombotic Ischemic events.

PLATOLANZA: Randomized, double-blind, parallel group, phase 3, efficacy and safety study of AZD6140 compared with Clopidogrel for prevention with non-ST Elevation or ST Elevation Acute Coronary Syndromes (ACS).

RED-HF: Randomized, double-blind, placebo controlled, multi-center study to assess the efficacy and safety of Darbepoetin alfa treatment on mortality and morbidity in Heart Failure (HF) subjects with Symptomatic Left Ventricular Systolic Dysfunction and Anemia.

STRIKE: A phase 2, randomized, parallel group, multi-center, multi-national study for the evaluation of four fixed dose regimens of DU-176b in subjects with Non-Valvular Atrial Fibrillation.

ASCEND: Double-blind, placebo-controlled, multi-center acute study of clinical effectiveness of Nesiritide in subjects with Decompensated Heart Failure.
